Bush Tucker Garden

In the last week of Term 3 the teachers and students from Kinder to Year 5 helped plant a new native garden outside the school on Hewlett St. The garden is split into two sections, one contains edible native plants (bush tucker) and the other contains critically endangered Eastern Suburbs Banksia Scrub (ESBS) which is the native scrub species that used to cover the Eastern Suburbs before European Settlement (only 3% remains).

The garden creates a great platform to integrate Aboriginal Education into the curriculum.

The garden was sponsored by Bronte P&C and planted out by IndigiGrow a not-for-profit with a small nursery in La Parouse Public School (you can visit with the kids) that aims to re-connect Aboriginal Australians with their bush food, increase representation of indigenous Australians in horticulture and educate Australians about the use of native plants.

The first few months will be critical for the garden as the plants establish themselves. **We ask that parents and students keep off the garden beds and refrain from eating anything from it until next year.**

Principal's Message

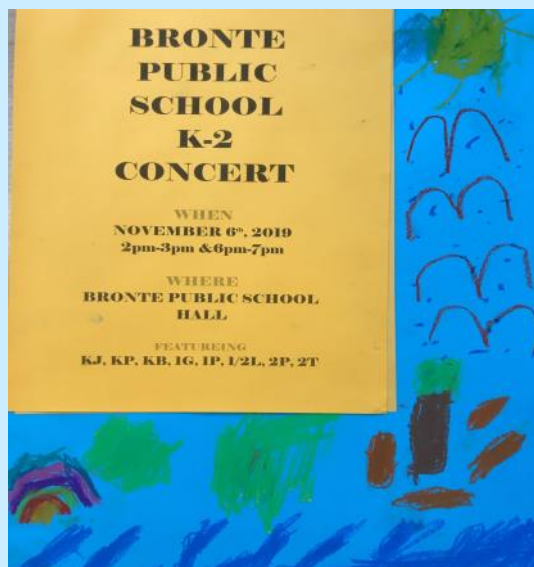
Hi All,
