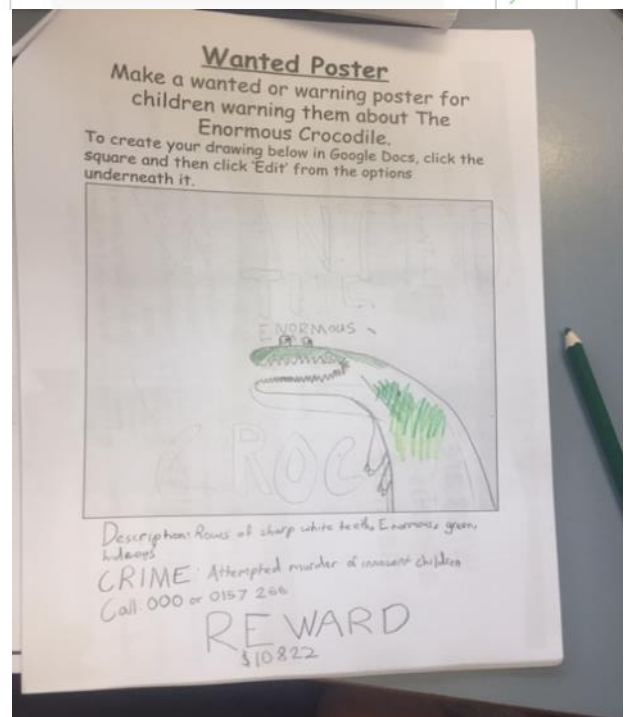

Bronte PS Library has close to 2000 eBooks for students and staff to access 24/7 through ePlatform.

You can use iOS, Android devices, PC's, laptops, tablets, iPads and eBook readers to read these eBooks. Use your internet browser or get the [ePlatform app](#).

We also have a subscription to [WORLD BOOK](#) online resources, containing an encyclopaedia of thousands of informational articles, videos, interactive maps, research help, activities and games.

Students use their Department of Education (DoE) user id and password to access these resources (the same one they use to logon to all school devices).

Steps for accessing Student Portal

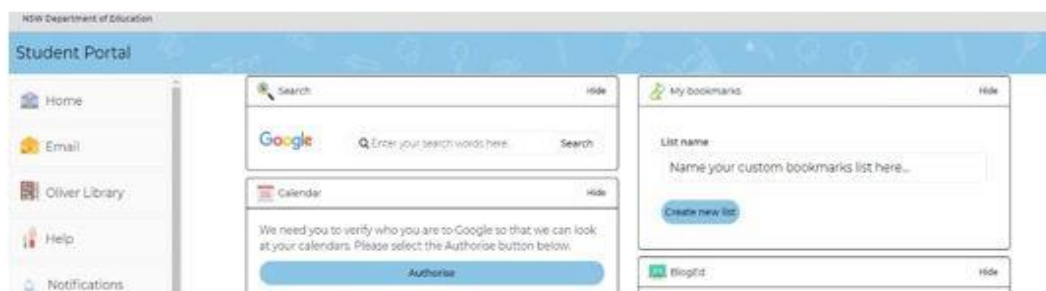
- 1) Enter in google search education.nsw.gov.au
- 2) From the Login drop down menu (top right-hand side) go to the Student portal.

This will always keep students safe online while at home. If they use the google search in the student portal, they can search online without fear of accessing inappropriate material.

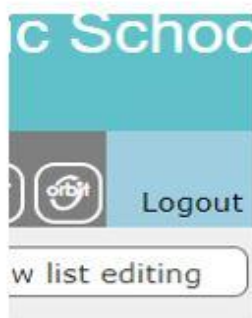
- 3) Enter DoE, Student User Id and Password (the one you use to sign on to all school computers). **For example User Id: bell.smith1 Password: ks**

Steps for accessing Orbit

1) Click on Oliver library
