Dear Parents,

We have been back at school for two weeks and the students continue to be ecstatic to see one another and their teachers every day! We have maintained our focus on a healthy environment for everyone. All library books and home reading books are wiped and placed in quarantine before they are reused and classrooms are vacuumed and wiped down every day. We have an extra cleaner that arrives in the middle of the day to clean the high use areas including the student bathrooms.

Winter PSSA sport for students in Years 3-6 has been cancelled for the rest of Term 2. This decision has not been made at the local school level but reflects the guidance from the department of Health and the Department of Education. Teachers are planning non contact Physical education programs for students to participate in at school.

If your child is in Year 4 you might think of applying for Year 5 entry into an Opportunity class OC. Information regarding the OC will be sent home with students. Please complete the form to let us know if you intend to apply.

Student reports will be sent home in Week 10 this term. The report has been adjusted in recognition of the impact of learning from home and at school during Term 1 and 2, 2020. Reflecting the many adjustments required from students, parents and the school, this report will not grade student achievement using the A-E scale. The teacher comment will describe your child's progress and achievement in the learning covered during Term 1 and Term 2 and identify what can be done to support their learning growth. The report will focus on the learning undertaken in English and mathematics.

The grading scale used in the report is represented below.

WT –Working Towards (The student is working towards grade level)

WA- Working At (The student is working at grade level)

WB – Working Beyond (The student has surpassed grade level)

We have registered our school to do ICAS examinations later in the year. See the information in this newsletter and remember to enrol your child before the 17th of July. ICAS assessments are designed to recognise and reward students academic excellence.

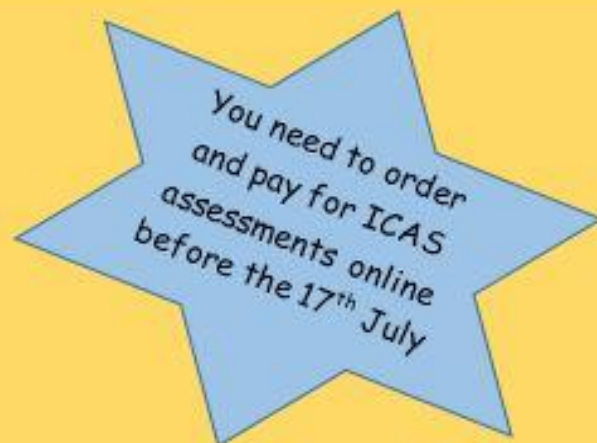
