Year 5 and Year 3 Online Assessments (Reading and Numeracy)

Although NAPLAN was cancelled earlier this year, Bronte Public School is committed to the academic progress of our students and will conduct the NSW Department of Education's online reading and numeracy 'Check-in' for students in Years 3 and 5.

The check-in assessments will be conducted as follows:

Year 5 students: Term 3, Week 7 (31 August to 4 September 2020)

Year 3 students: Term 3, Week 10 (21 September to 25 September 2020)

The Check-in assessment supplements existing school practices to identify how students are performing in literacy and numeracy and to help teachers tailor their teaching more specifically to student needs. The assessments are mapped to the NSW Syllabuses and National Literacy and Numeracy Learning Progression.
